# WHY?

- V7 & 8 - ,In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show **integrity**, **seriousness** ,and **soundness of speech** that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have **nothing bad to say** about us.
- integrity - being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness
- serious - 1. (of a person) solemn or thoughtful in character or manner 2. acting or speaking sincerely and in earnest, rather than in a joking or halfhearted manner.
- sound - competent, sensible, or valid; having no defect as to truth, justice, wisdom, or reason:
